# Uniform Policy

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## 1. Introduction and Purpose

At The Grammar Junior School, we take pride in presenting a unified and professional image that reflects our school's values and high standards. The school uniform promotes equality, belonging, and respect among students, while also encouraging a sense of personal responsibility and discipline. By wearing the uniform correctly, students demonstrate pride in themselves and in being members of The Grammar Junior School community.

## 2. General Expectations

Students are expected to arrive at school each day wearing the complete and correct school uniform. Uniforms should be clean, well-fitted, and neatly presented at all times. All items of clothing and personal belongings should be clearly labelled with the student's name. Parents and guardians are kindly asked to ensure their children attend school dressed according to the school's uniform standards and to support the school in maintaining a consistent appearance among all students.

## 3. Uniform Guidelines

The school uniform is designed to be comfortable, practical, and age-appropriate, while maintaining a smart and cohesive look. The following guidelines apply to all students unless otherwise stated.

### Official Uniform

- **Anorak:** Blue, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Sweatshirt:** Maroon, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School with the School logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Polo Shirt:**
  - **Winter:** White with long sleeves for the winter specially designed for The Grammar Junior School with the School logo.
  - **Summer:** Maroon with short sleeves for the summer, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School with the School logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Shorts/ Trousers:** Grey.
- **Skorts:** Grey, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School. Available only at "Victuar" clothing shop.
- **Pinafore:** Grey, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School. Available only at "Victuar" clothing shop.
- **Shoes / Trainers:** All black.
- **Socks:** Black, White or Grey.

#### 4. Physical Education

Students should wear their PE uniform only on the days they have PE or after-school sports clubs.

- **T-shirt:** White, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School with the School logo.  
Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Shorts:** Grey, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School with the School logo.  
Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Track suit:** Grey, specially designed for The Grammar Junior School with the School logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Socks:** White or Grey.
- **Trainers:** Any colour

#### 5. Accessories and Personal Appearance

Students are expected to maintain a neat and tidy appearance. The following guidelines apply:

- **Jewellery:** Only small stud earrings may be worn. No other jewellery or accessories are permitted.
- **Hair:** Extreme hairstyles or unnatural hair colours are not allowed.
- **Make-up and Nail Polish:** Not permitted.

#### 6. Seasonal Guidelines

The school uniform differs slightly between the winter and summer terms to ensure students' comfort in different weather conditions. Announcements will be made at the beginning of each term regarding when the change of uniform is expected.

#### 7. Compliance and Support

Wearing the correct uniform is part of our school's expectations and code of conduct. If a student repeatedly attends school without the proper uniform, parents will be contacted to resolve the issue. Should exceptional circumstances arise, parents are expected to inform the school in advance so that appropriate arrangements can be made before sending their child to school. We appreciate parents' cooperation and continued support in upholding our uniform standards, which help our students represent The Grammar Junior School with pride and confidence.

The school reserves the right to ask a student to correct any aspect of appearance that does not align with the uniform policy.
